We are continually trying to improve our products and instructions – please help us by providing feedback and pictures if you find any part of the instructions that do not match your Jeep or are not easily understandable.



IMPORTANT NOTE: We use Stainless Steel Hardware where possible. Therefore, a tube of Silver Anti-seize is provided and should be used on all bolts—only a small amount is needed.

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Tools Required: This list is the recommended tools for ease of installation. Other versions of the same tool can be used. For example, Allen Wrenches instead of Allen Drive Sockets.



HOW TO USE THIS GUIDE: The installation guide contains ALL steps for installation. Please read and follow the instructions in order of each page top to bottom and left to right.

Jeep Model: Instructions may apply to multiple Jeep models but are labeled separately where appropriate (i.e. TJ vs. LJ). **Options:** Because of the number of component options we offer, these instructions may contain steps that will not match your configuration. You can skip these steps.

Step 1: Remove Factory Components

- A. Remove your TJ's rear bench seat.
- B. Remove the bottom seatbelt mounts using a T50 Torx.
- C. Remove the rear two seat brackets using a T50 Torx Bit making sure to note which way is forward on the bracket, as you will be reinstalling these later.





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Step 2: Cargo Side Bracket Installation

- D. Align each of the cargo rack side brackets with its corresponding side of the vehicle.
- E. Using the stainless-steel button head bolts (BOM #4) and the stainless-steel washers (BOM #5) bolt the side brackets to the rivet nuts on the tub of the Jeep using a 4mm allen wrench.
- F. Using a T50 Torx bit reinstall the two seat brackets on top of the cargo side brackets.





Step 3: Cargo Basket Installation

- G. Place the basket in the rear of your jeep between the brackets with the ARS logo closest to you.
- H. Take all the thumb screws (BOM #9) and place a lock washer (BOM #6) on each, followed by a larger washer (BOM #7).
- I. Lift the "M" side of the basket and place a nylon sleeve washer (BOM #3) in both side slots on the basket between the basket and side bracket closest to the "M" Side.





Step 3: Cargo Basket Installation

- J. Thread your thumb screw with washers through the basket, nylon washer, and side bracket and lightly screw on the thumb nut (BOM #10) on both mounting slots closet to the front of the jeep.
- K. Repeat the process for the slots closest to you, this time placing the basket at your desired height holes (you can adjust the height of the basket on the "M" side by moving it up or down in the slots).
- L. Tighten all hardware at your desired height.
