#### **Step 1:** Plastic Bumper Note


**Note:** If you have a plastic bumper you will need to install the provided rivet nut at the two hex head locations (A) at the cross member. You may need to drill the holes out to 17/32"



## **Section 3:** Installation Instructions

### Step 2: Muffler Skid Installation






- B. Using a 15mm socket disconnect the rear sway bar bolts.
- C. Insert the provided skid hangers on top of the sway bar mount and loosely install the stock sway bar mount bolts.

**Note:** This skid is also compatible with the MetalCloak rear sway bar 4in drop bracket (7026), install the skid mount within the drop block, in the stock sway bar location using the stock bolts.













### Step 2: Muffler Skid Installation





- D. Hold the muffler skid plate to the muffler and using a 17mm socket loosely install the provided bolts at the two rear bumper bolt locations
- E. Using a 9/16 socket and wrench loosely install the skid hangers to the skid plate.
- F. Tighten all hardware.
