






**Step 1:** Passenger Side Press In Bushing

**Important Note:** This installation may be done on the ground and should be done one side at a time to closer match the caster that has already been set. If you are using a lift, you must remove the lower side of the track bar off the front axle to keep the track bar from pulling the axle off center before raising the Jeep.

- A. Remove the passenger side upper front control arm from the axle.
- B. Press out the passenger side OEM bushing using the bushing press.
- C. Press in the MetalCloak Duroflex housing from the passenger side inward till the passenger side face of the Duroflex housing is even with the passenger side face of the axle casting.












#### **Step 1:** Passenger Side Press In Bushing

- D. Install one retaining washer making sure the sharp edge of the ring is oriented outward from the center of the housing.
- E. Use the provided synthetic silicon/Teflon lubricant to lightly coat the outside of the Duroflex bushing paying special attention to partially filling the outside diameter grooves.
- F. Install Duroflex bushing.
- G. Install the second retaining washer.
- H. Install the snap ring on the end of the housing making sure the sharp edge of the ring is oriented outward from the center of the housing.
- I. Reinstall the upper front control arm.













Step 2: Driver Side Press In Bushing

**Important Note:** When pressing out/in the bushing housing on the driver side be carful not to break the differential breather tube.

- J. Remove the driver side upper front control arm from the axle.
- K. Press out the driver side OEM bushing using the bushing press.
- L. Press in the MetalCloak Duroflex housing from the driver side inward till the driver side face of the Duroflex housing is even with the driver side face of the axle casting.











#### Step 2: Driver Side Press In Bushing

- M. Install one retaining washer making sure the sharp edge of the ring is oriented outward from the center of the housing.
- N. Use the provided synthetic silicon/Teflon lubricant to lightly coat the outside of the Duroflex bushing paying special attention to partially filling the outside diameter grooves.
- O. Install Duroflex bushing.
- P. Install the second retaining washer.
- Q. Install the snap ring on the end of the housing making sure the sharp edge of the ring is oriented outward from the center of the housing.
- R. Reinstall the upper front control arm.











Step 3: Adjustments (if applicable)

- S. Reinstall the lower side of the track bar (If disconnected).
- T. Check and rest the caster if needed.
- U. The Duroflex housing can be spray painted after the bushing is installed to provide some environmental protection.
