

Options: Because of the number of component options we offer, these instructions may contain steps that will not match your particular configuration. You can skip these steps.












Step 1: Disconnect The Passenger Side Taillight

- A. Twist the lever under the fender flare to release the back of the flare from the body and pull flare away.
- B. Pull off the body panel under the passenger side taillight.
- C. Using a Phillips head screwdriver remove the 4 plastic rivet nuts from the trim panel inside by the tailgate hinges.
- D. Use a 10mm deep socket to remove the two bolts from the trim panel.











Step 1: Disconnect The Passenger Side Taillight

- E. Remove the trim panel.
- F. Use an 8mm socket to remove the two bolts hiding underneath that panel (F1) and a 10mm socket to remove one bolt on the side of the taillight (F2).
- G. Unplug the taillight and remove the taillight.











Step 2: Wiring

- H. Using a razer blade or exact-o knife put a small cut in the weather striping to run the wire to the taillight plug on the bronco. Make the cut in the same area that the wires from the tailgate wiring loom are (you will be using the loom to run the new wire to the tailgate).
- I. Cut the plug off the wire provided (it does not matter which plug end you remove as you will be removing the plug on the other end later).
- J. Loosely install the plastic trim panel that goes by the hinges. Then run the wire the weather stripping and mark the panel with a marker.
- K. Remove the plastic trim panel and drill the hole with a 1/4" drill bit.










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Step 2: Wiring

- L. Loosely reinstall the plastic trim panel and run the wire through the newly made hole.
- M. Use the supplied connectors to tie into the wiring for the brake and running lights. Follow the diagram below.
- N. Cut off the plug on the other end of the supplied wire.




Step 2: Wiring

- O. Pull the two plastic covers off the tailgate to access the wires behind them.
- P. Cut a small hole in the loom that runs to the tailgate. You will run the new wire in the loom to get it over to the tailgate cleanly.
- Q. Cut another small hole in the loom on the tailgate side to pull the new wire back out of the loom.
- R. Feed the new wire into the first hole in the loom and back out the second hole.










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Step 2: Wiring

- S. Using a 13mm socket loosen the eight spare tire mount bolts.
- T. Next use the second supplied wire; the wire that has a short side and long side (the short side will be used on the license plate end).
- U. Run the long end of the wire to the rubber gromet that the factory wires come through the tailgate. Leave about 18" 20" of wire from the tailgate to the new license plate mount.
- V. You will need to drill a 1/4" hole in the gromet next to the factory wires.










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Step 2: Wiring

- W. Run the wire through the hole and follow the stock shock wiring to the middle of the tailgate.
- X. Use the supplied connectors and connect the wires together. Follow the diagram below.
- Y. Zip tie the wires to the factory wiring.
- Z. Reinstall the plastic covers on the tailgate.



Step 3: License Plate Mount Installation

- AA. Install the third brake light onto license plate mount.
- BB. Using the provided hardware install the license plate light onto the license plate mount and tighten the hardware using a 7/16" socket and Philips head screwdriver.
- CC. Splice the brake light and license plate light wiring to the short plug wire provided. Follow the diagram below for wiring.










Step 3: License Plate Mount Installation

- DD. Install the spare tire and the provided lug stand-offs (BOM#1) (DD1) to attach the license plate mount base (BOM #3) using the provided hardware (DD2).
- EE. Install the license plate mount to the base using the provided washer and thumb screw knob. Alternatively, you can use the supplied serrated flange head bolt for additional security
- FF. Install license plate to the license plate mount.
- GG. Check the lights to make sure they are working properly.









Step 4: Taillight Installation

- HH. Reconnect the taillight and reinstall the taillight.
- II. Use an 8mm socket to reinstall the two bolts on the side of the taillight (II1) and a 10mm socket to install the one bolt on the side of the taillight (II2).
- JJ. Install the trim panel.











Step 4: Taillight Installation

- KK. Use a 10mm deep socket to remove the two bolts from the trim panel
- LL. Using a Phillips head screwdriver tighten the 4 plastic rivet nuts on the trim panel inside by the tailgate hinges.
- MM.Reinstall the body panel under the passenger side taillight.
- NN. Twist the lever under the fender flare to release the back of the flare from the body and pull flare away.
