

**Options:** Because of the number of component options we offer, these instructions may contain steps that will not match your particular configuration. You can skip these steps.



## **Section 2: Product Components**







Step 1: Remove the Factory Bumper

- A. Remove the spare tire using a 19mm socket.
- B. Remove the trailer brake plugs using a 10mm socket and pinch the silver retaining tabs behind the plug to release it.
- C. Disconnect the parking sensor wire plugs on both sides of the vehicle.
- D. Remove the bolts from the bottom of the factory bumper. At the bottom of the bumper remove the four 18mm bolts that bolt through the recovery points behind the bumper.
- E. Remove the 13mm bolts using a socket or wrench.
- F. Remove the stock bumper.












Step 2: Rear Bumper Disassembly

- G. Using a 13mm socket remove all the interior brackets on the factory bumper.
- H. Use a plastic trim tool to remove the plastic "Christmas trees" that hold the parking sensors wiring in place.
- I. Remove the sensors from the bumper by pulling back the side tabs that are holding the sensors in.












**Step 3:** MetalCloak Bumper Assembly

J. Take MetalCloak bumper caps and install the cap supports using the provided hardware with 3/4" socket and 7/32" allen.










**Step 3:** MetalCloak Bumper Assembly

- K. Install the D-ring mounts using the provided hardware with a 22mm socket.
- L. Install the provided nut clips to the tabs on the end caps and one onto the trim plate.
- M. Install the trim plate using the provided hardware with a 5/32" allen wrench.











**Step 3:** MetalCloak Bumper Assembly

- N. Install the end caps to the bumper base using the provided hardware using a 3/4" socket.
- O. Install the light fill mount bracket on the inside of the bumper if you do not plan on installing lights, using a 9/16" socket and wrench.







**Step 3:** MetalCloak Bumper Assembly

- P. Install the bumper sensor retainers by pushing them through the front.
- Q. Install the parking sensors, making sure you install the sensors in the same orientation as the factory bumper had them.
- R. Install the trailer plug by pushing it through the bumper by hand.









#### **Step 4:** MetalCloak Rear Bumper Installation


- S. Take your assembled bumper and install it on the vehicle using the factory 18mm bolts.
- T. Plug in the trailer plug and parking brake sensors.
- U. Install the provided reinforcement bracket using the 3/4" bolts through the rear body mount and in to welded nut in the cap supports.
- V. Tighten all hardware.











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
